- All roll players will be required to sign “WAIVER OF LIABILITY & HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT” prior to application of SFX.
- Note all actors should come prepared to get messy. The team will be working with makeup, latex products, glues, and fake blood. So, we ask that they wear clothes that they do not mind getting stained (Moulage team will attempt to bring clothing that matches injuries). While the products wash off skin with soap and water (some minor staining may occur), we cannot guarantee they will not stain clothing, so please wear things you do mind getting stained.
- **Live roll players should not be used as deceased casualties during an exercise unless they begin the exercise still alive. LHD Moulage Team will not perform SFX injuries for individuals indicated to be DOA on live roll players! All Deceased RP should be mannequins.**

Lake Health District requires at least 30 days’ notice prior to a planned event, to make schedule arrangements for Moulage staff as these positions are additional duties to their normal work schedules.
